




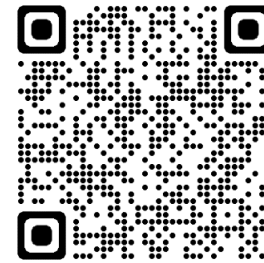
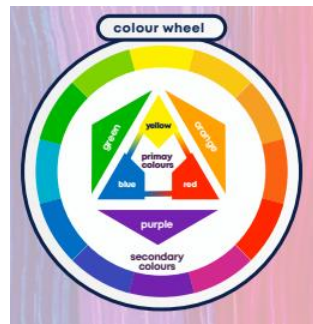


Key Words	Definitions
