




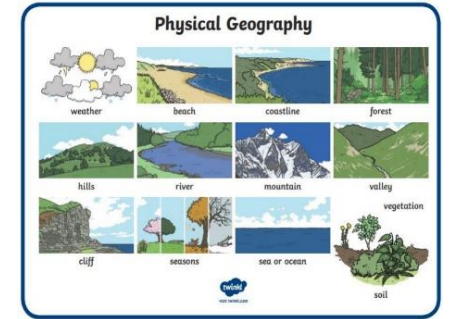
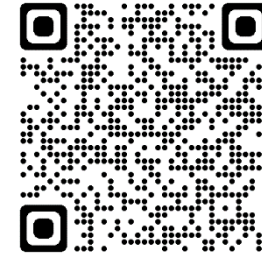
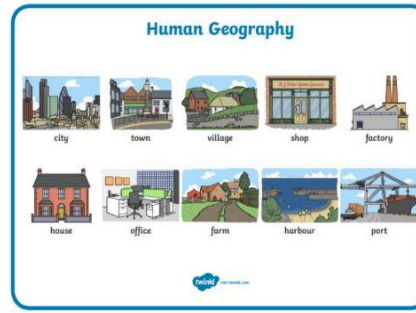


Key Words	Definitions	
<b>Spring</b>	The season that follows Winter. The spring months are March, April and May.	
<b>crocus</b>	A short flower that grows in spring. They can be white, purple or yellow.	
<b>daffodil</b>	A yellow flower on a long green stalk with green leaves growing from the bottom of the stem. It grows in Spring.	
<b>snowdrop</b>	A white drooping bell-shaped flower that grows in spring.	
<b>tulip</b>	A tall cup-shaped brightly coloured flower that grows in spring. They can be different colours.	

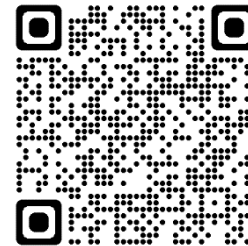
**Geography – We will be looking at human and physical features of the world around us. Human features are made by people. Physical features are made by nature and are not man-made.**

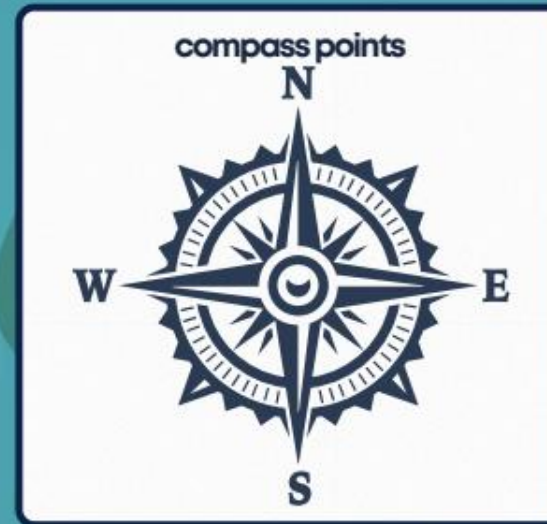
