








Year Reception – Autumn 2 – In the Woods









Key Words	Description	
brown bear		A brown bear is a big, furry animal with a strong body. It loves to explore forests and rivers in search of delicious berries and fish.
polar bear		A polar bear is a white, fluffy bear that lives in icy places like the Arctic. Polar bears are fantastic swimmers and hunt for seals in chilly waters.
badger		A badger is a furry animal with black and white stripes on its face. It loves to dig cosy homes called burrows in the ground.
bat		A bat is a flying animal with wings. It sleeps upside down in dark caves and comes out at night to eat bugs.
hedgehog		A hedgehog is a small spiky animal. Its little nose helps it sniff for insects and bugs at night.
owl		An owl is a bird. It has big, round eyes that help it see in the dark. It has feathers, a sharp beak, and claws to help it catch mice to eat.
day		Day is when it is bright outside because of the sun. People are active in the daytime.
night		Night is when it is dark outside. People sleep at nighttime. Some animals are active at nighttime. We call them nocturnal.

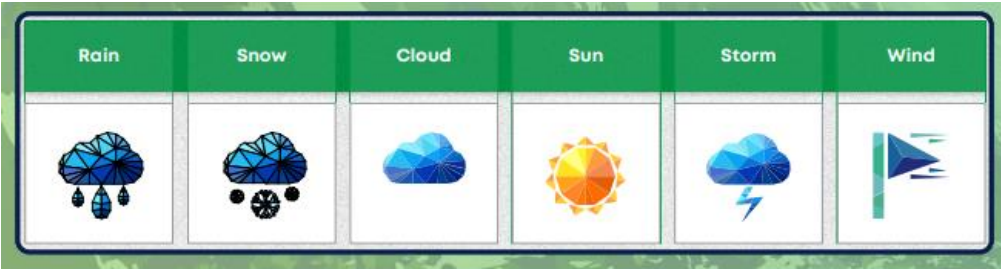
